An Memoriam—The *ANS* regrets the loss of another of its charter members. Guy C. Miller died on May 13, 1955, in Palo Alto, California. Mr. Miller was born in Salem, Oregon, the great-grandson of a western pioneer who came to Oregon in 1852. In 1904 he was the first letter carrier of Palo Alto. When he died he held the honorary position of City Historian of Palo Alto. For half a century he was engaged in the book trade and in historical research. Among other things he published a classical account of the meaning, origin, and application of the name Palo Alto.
