## Collections of the American Name Society December, 1963, to February, 1965

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The bibliographie below includes all material that has been added to the collections of the American Name Society since December, 1963. The list supplements those that have appeared in Names, 9 (1961), 277–288; Names, 11 (1963), 26–30; and Names, 12 (1964), 226–229. As pointed out in earlier announcements, the material is available for use by members of the Society, with the stipulation that it be returned within a reasonable time.

The archives are now shelved in a room on the 3rd floor of Morey Hall, The State University College at Potsdam, New York, where the office of the Society is located. The books and articles now cover a rather large area and fill several book shelves. Slowly but whether surely or not, the Society is developing a large collection that should point toward a research center in onomastics within the next few years. As editions of books and as more and more articles are secured for the archives, the outlook for establishing a center will certainly be improved. Members of the Society have been sending items, such as telephone or other directories and lists of names, to me for storing in the collections. There is room for much more. Furthermore, anyone who likes to prowl around in bookshops where used books are sold can probably pick up material that will be useful for the archives. Funds are available for reimbursing members who send in such purchased items.

I also hope that members will continue to report articles and feature items that appear in local magazines, state folklore magazines, and newspapers. Although the material may appear to be ephemeral, it may prove to be quite valuable to someone doing research in names.

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
